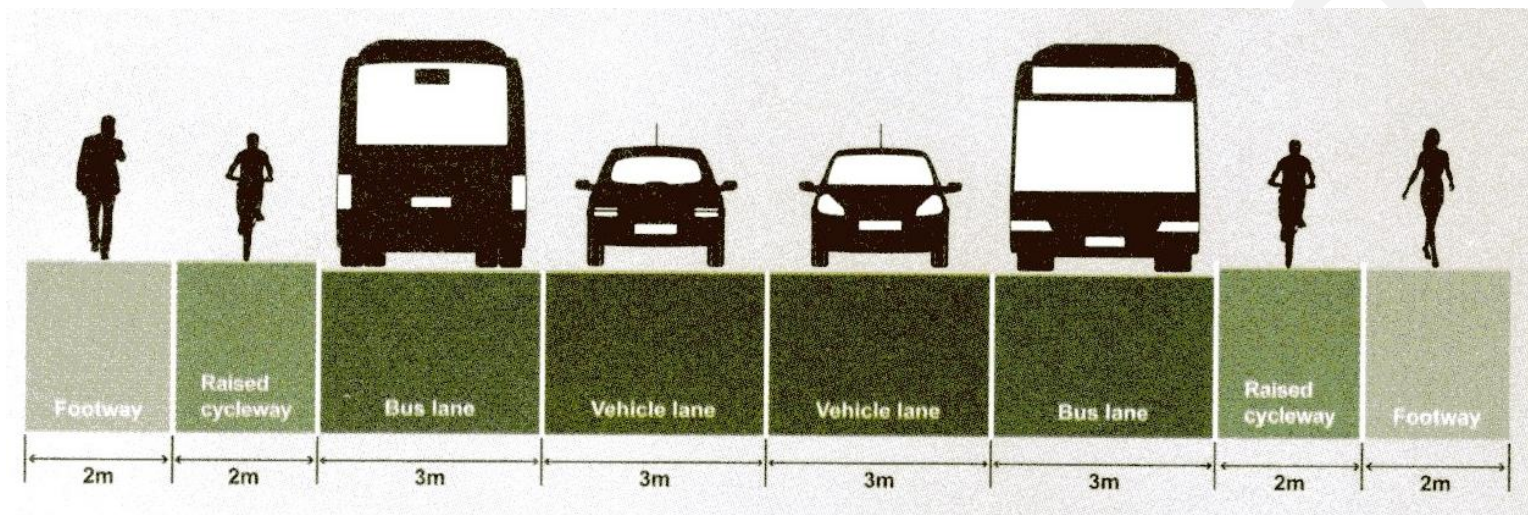

- “Milton Road bus priority”



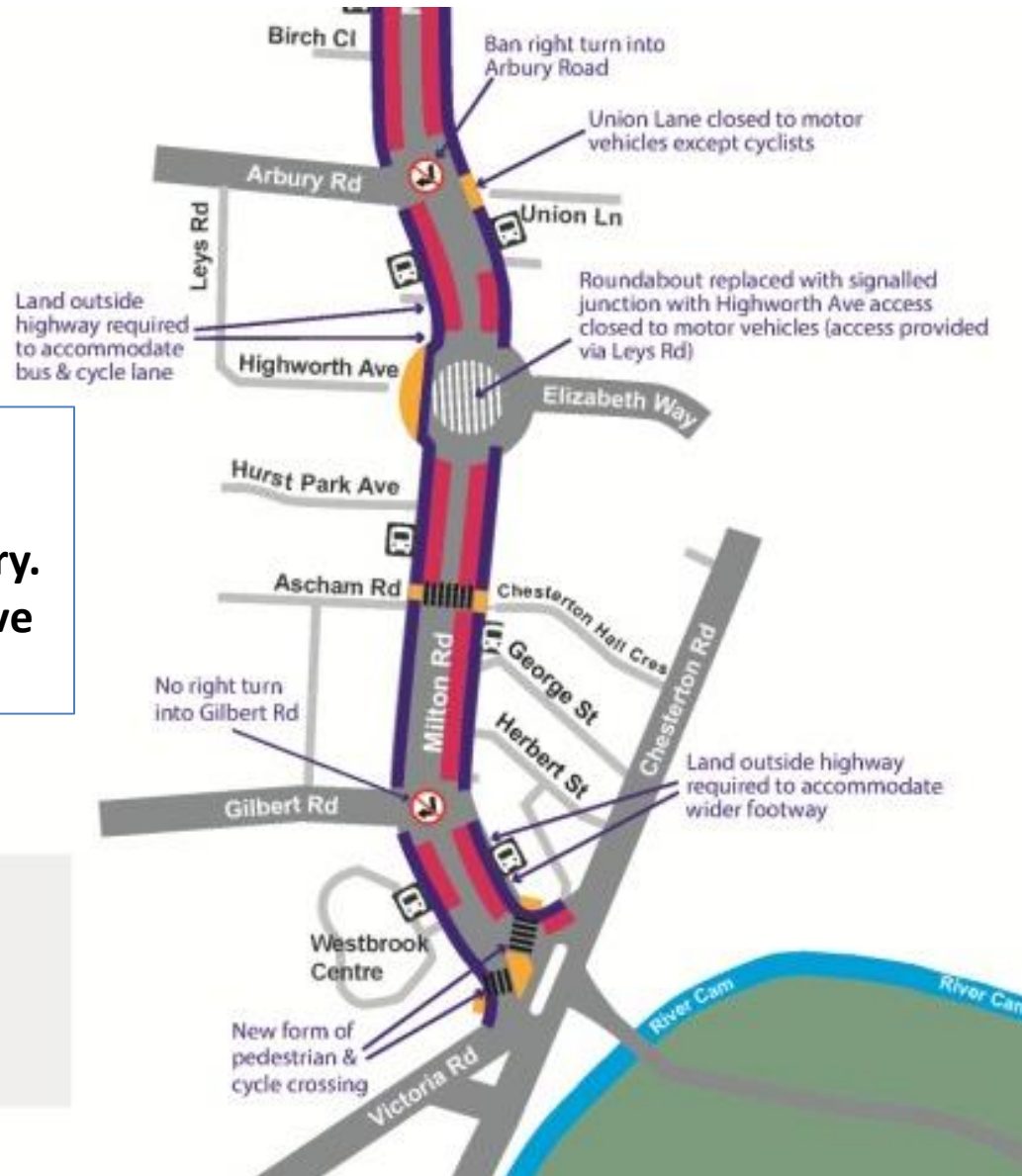
- “City Centre capacity improvements / cross-city cycle improvements”

-  Shared footpath & cycleway

Implications

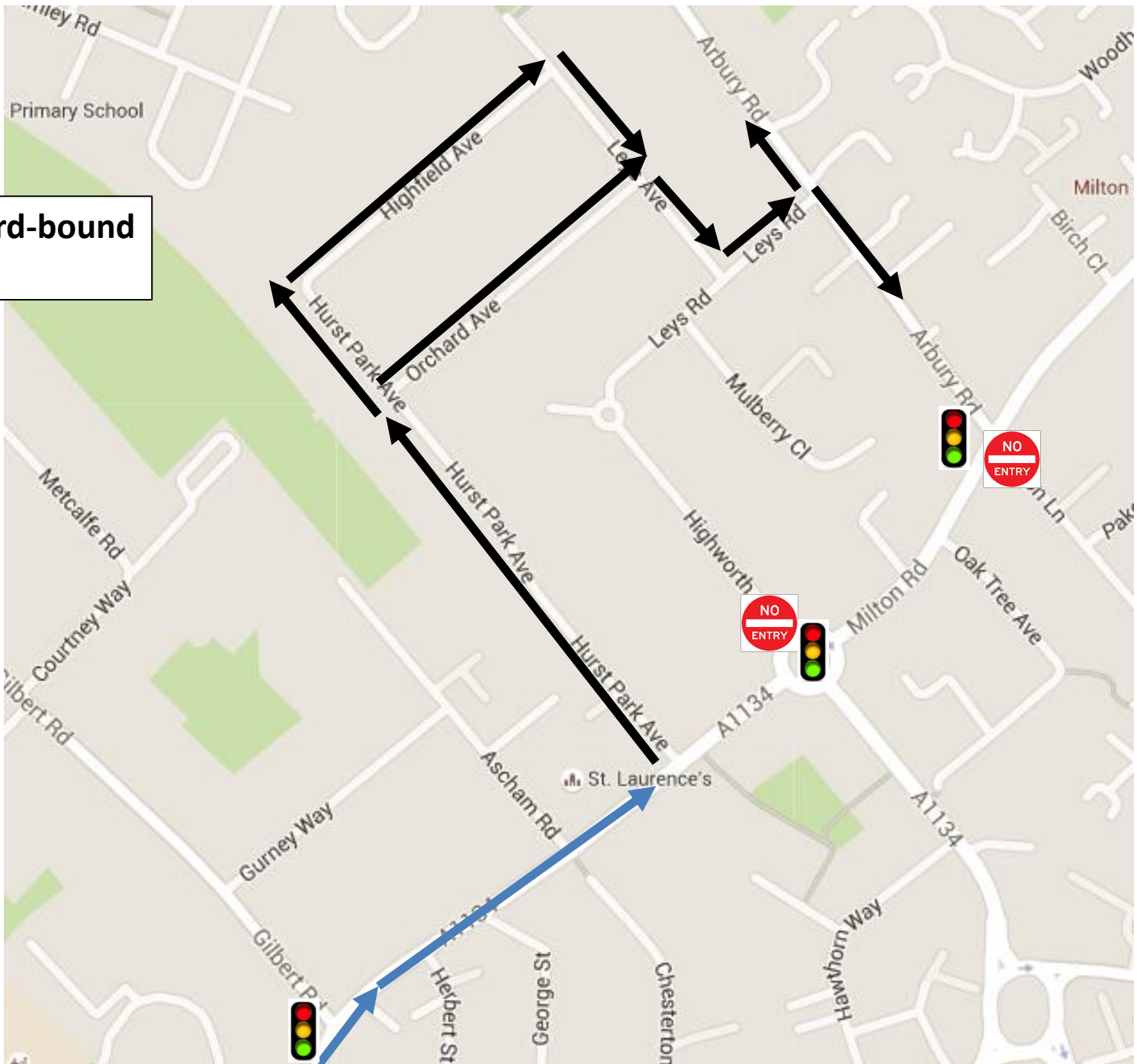
- **Increased N traffic through the estate**

Entering via Hurst Park Ave; exiting via Leys Rd

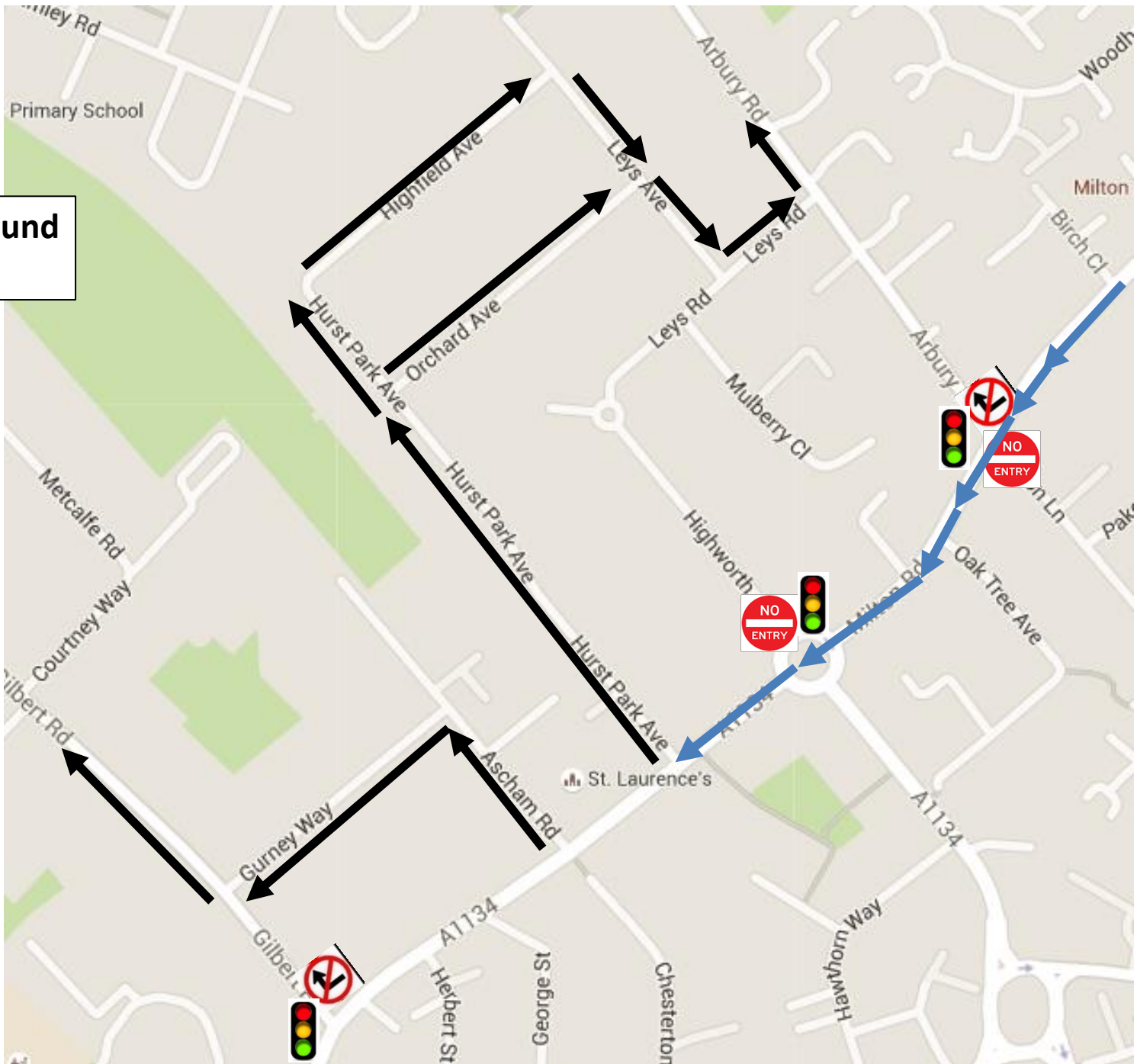
- **Increased S traffic through the estate**

Entering via Leys Rd; exiting via Hurst Park Ave

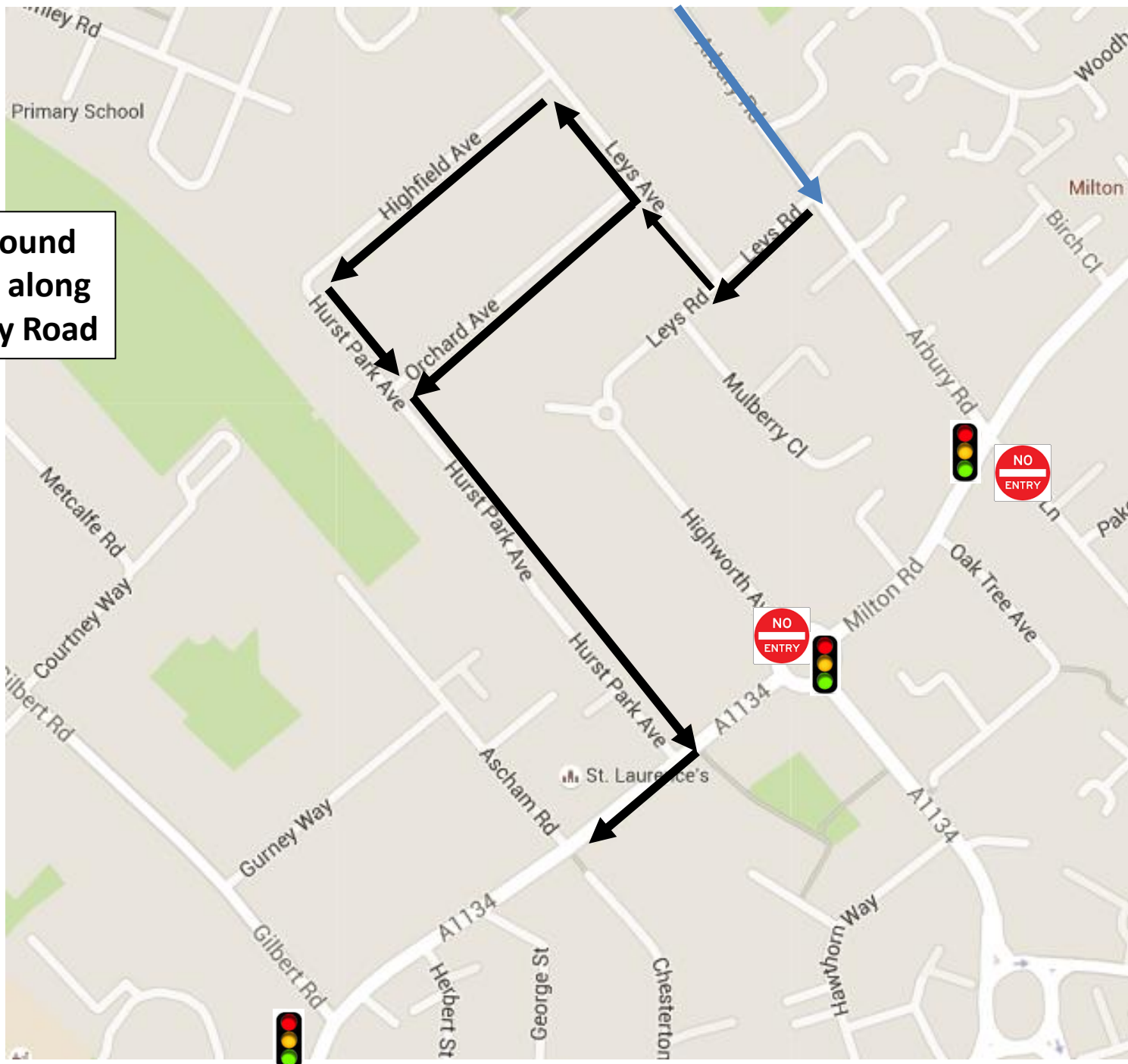
Outward-bound traffic



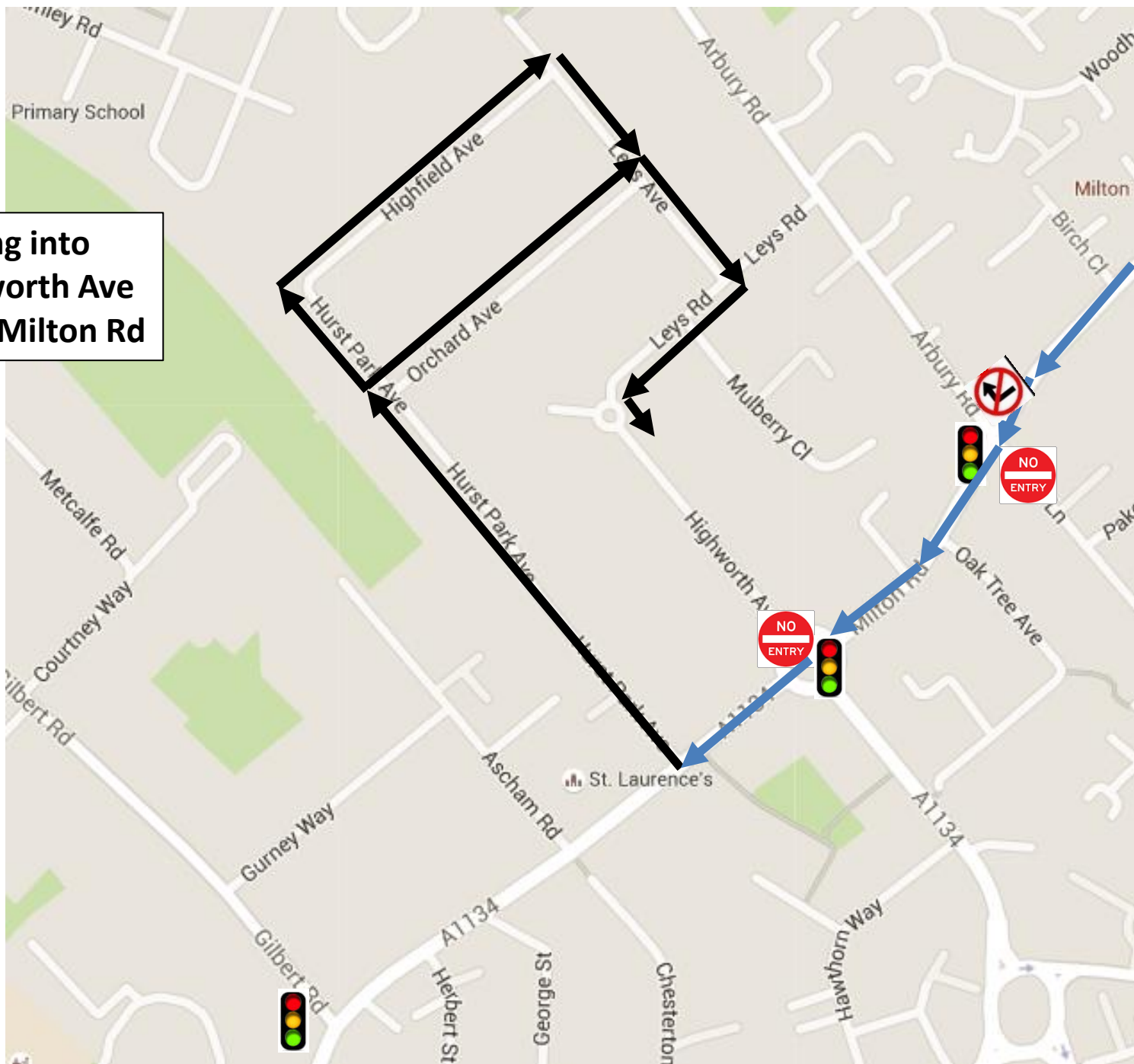
City-bound traffic

From Milton Rd**



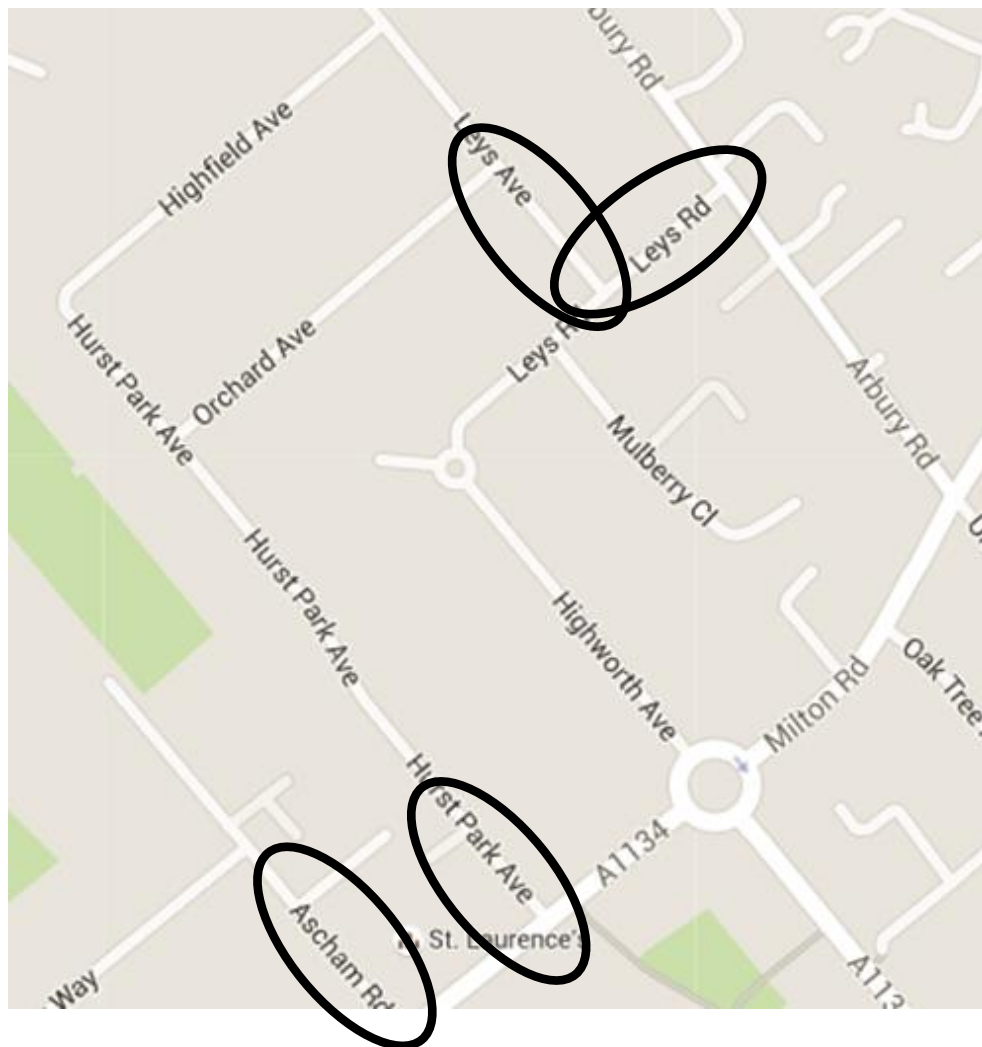
Critical Issues facing local residents

- pollution

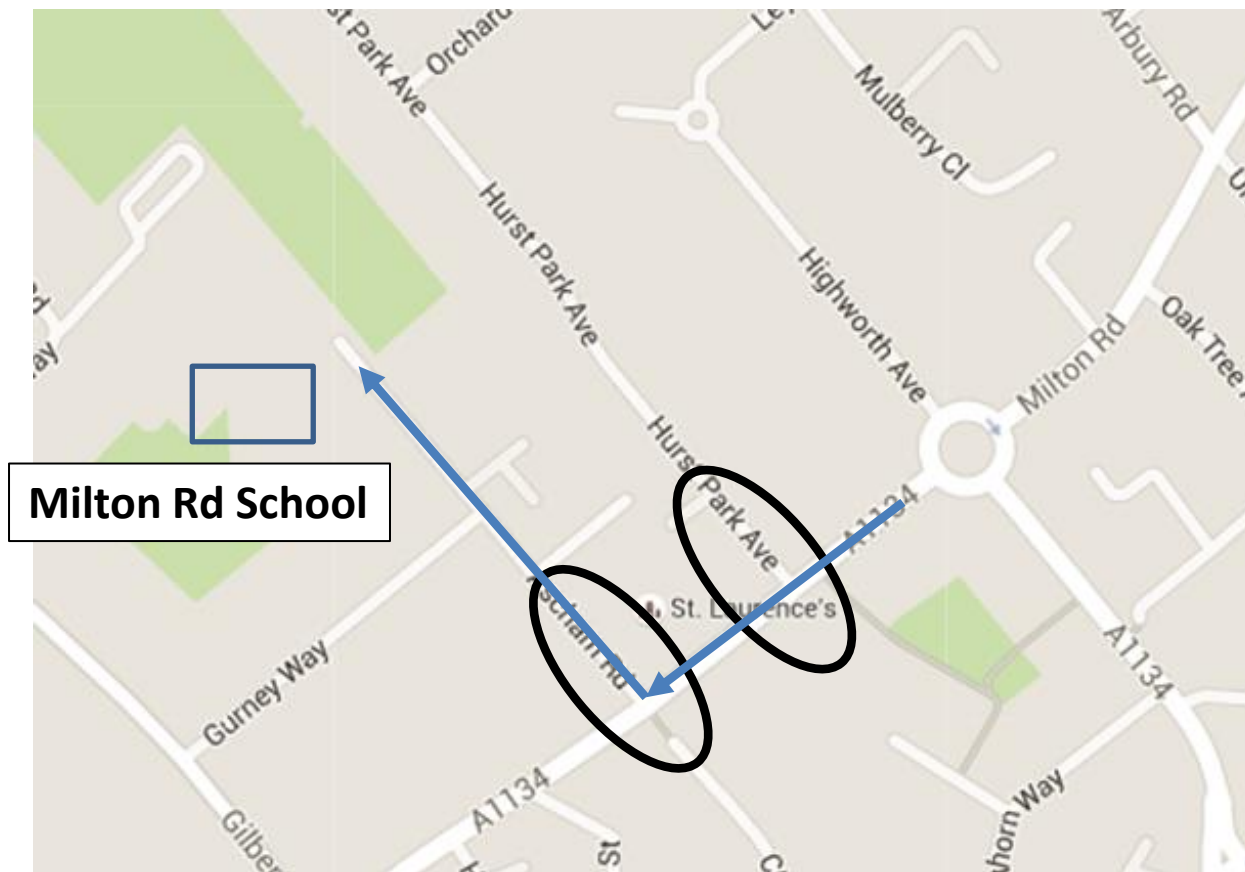
at exits from the estate.

Implications

- Increased danger for residents & cyclists, children and their parents/carers



Critical Issues facing local residents

Implications for Highworth Ave Residents

- **Change of flow direction**

Highworth Ave residents forced to take a longer and slower route, adding to the traffic at both exits. Also, there is no provision for turning.

- **Removal of the Roundabout**

The intersection has been classed as an **accident cluster**, but that has been achieved by including statistics related to another area.

- **Environmental Degradation**

The removal of roundabout greenery and the trees & hedges on the approach roads will be environmentally damaging, contributing to more noise for residents.

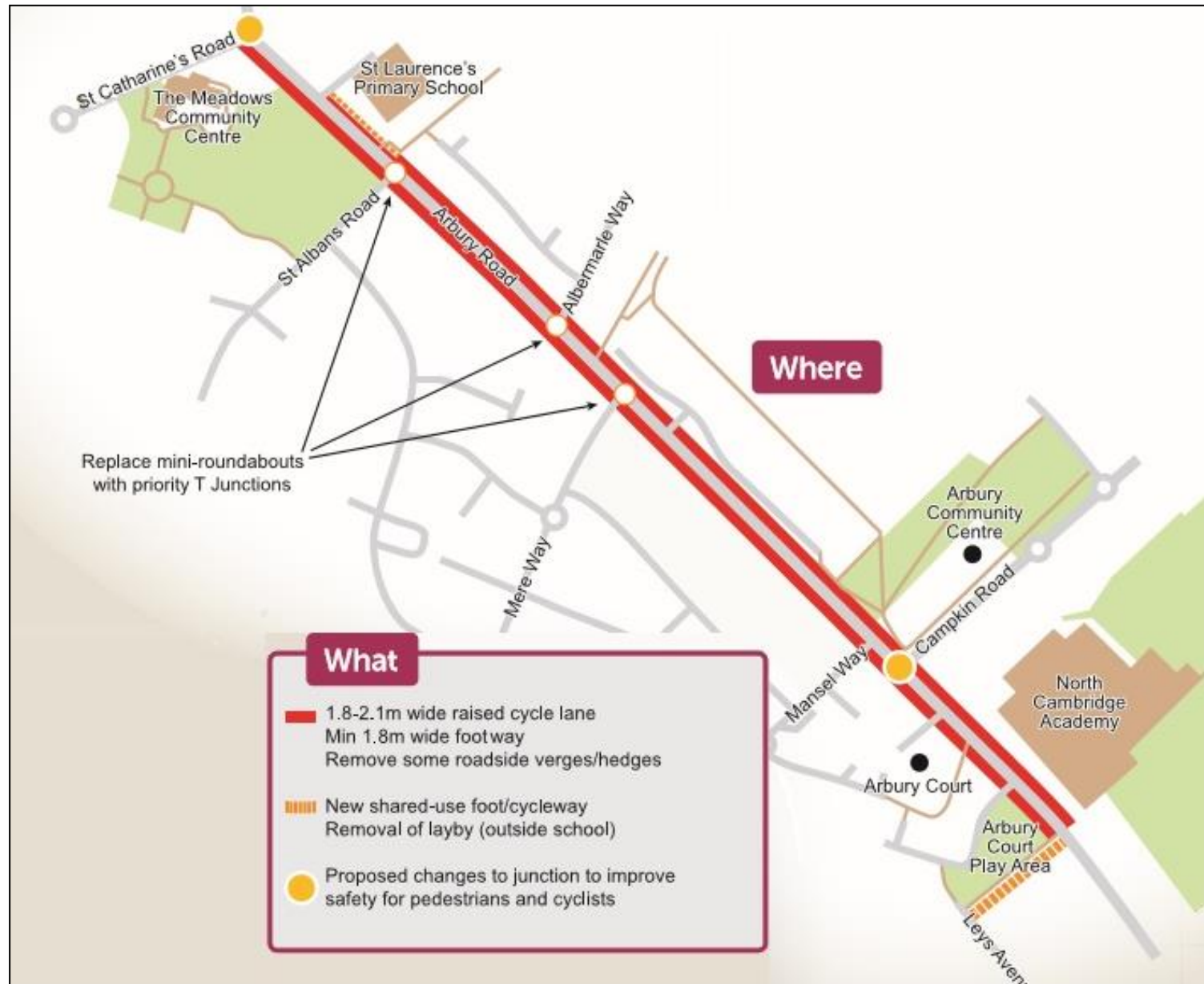
Cross-City Cycling

- Aimed at encouraging people who can, to cycle to work.

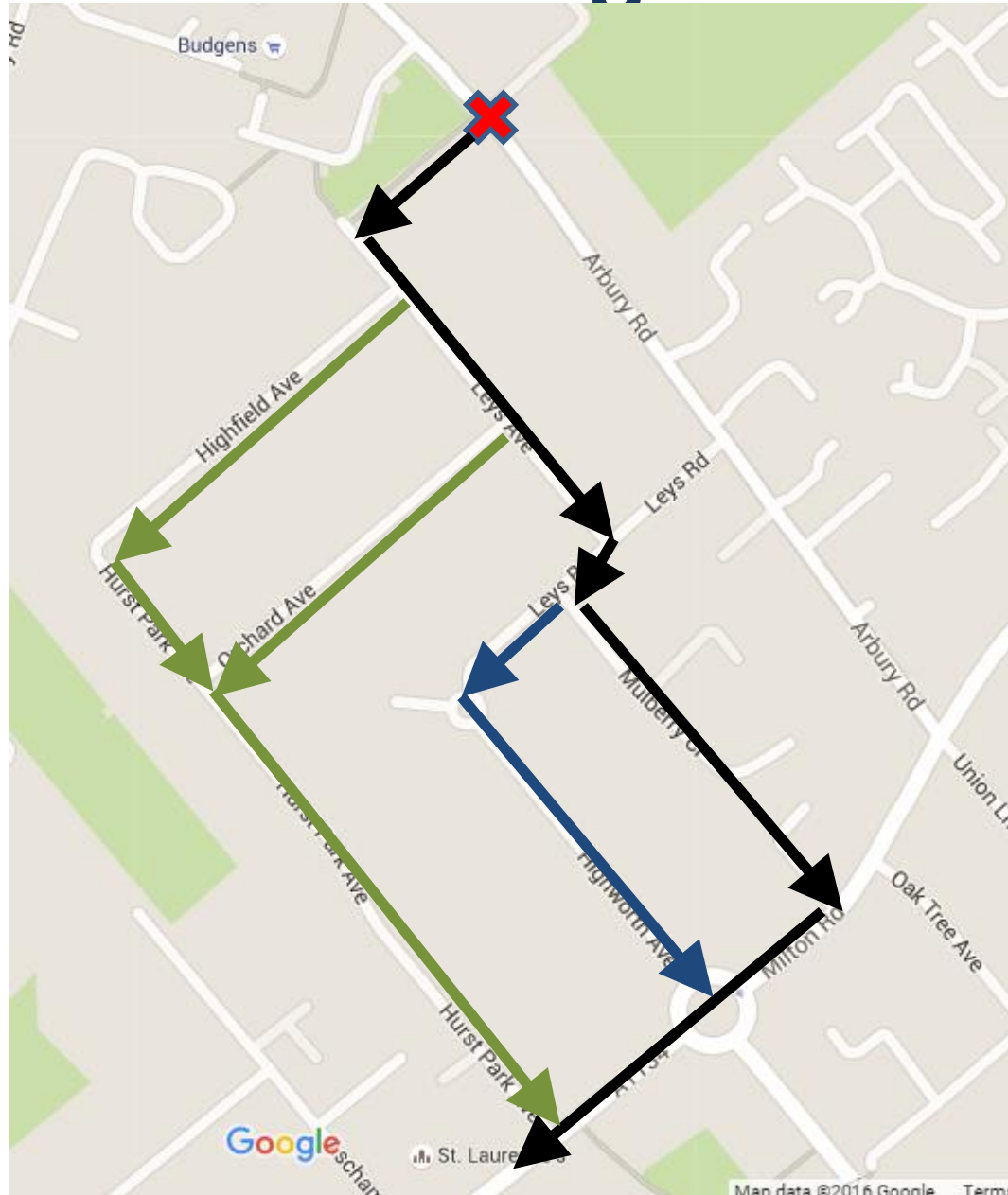
Arbury Road Route
